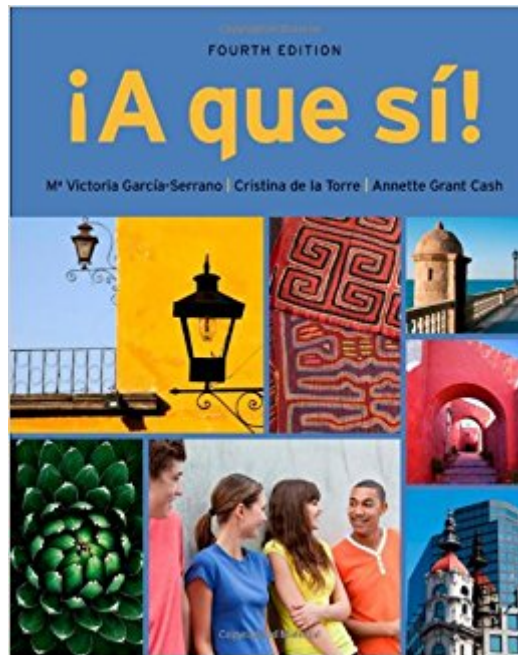




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A Que Si! (World Languages)

Each thematic unit is supported by creative activities and engaging authentic materials.
