

This is not the recent translation of "Hedda Gabler" by Doug Hughes. It is an ancient translation by Edmund Gosse and William Archer. You can probably find the identical text in paperback for \$1. I've only had my Kindle since X-mas 2009 and this is already my third encounter with deceptively labeled translations of plays. I am stunned that Kindle would allow such sloppiness. This is unprofessional and maddening. In one instance the preview showed the modern translation of a play I desired, but the purchased and downloaded e-book was archaic, obsolete trash.
