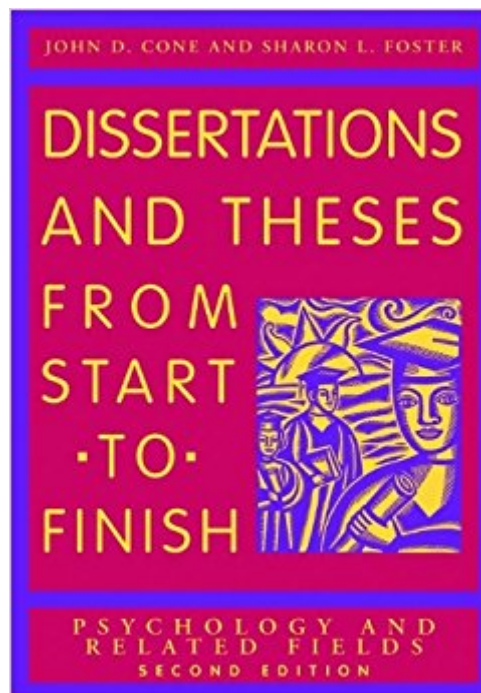




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Dissertations And Theses From Start To Finish: Psychology And Related Fields, Second Edition

I like this book, it is thorough with a lot of detail. There are some parts that may not be necessary for me, but it is better to have everything and not need some of it, than to have less and you need something that is left out. Another reviewer stated that this is too elementary and that if someone is getting a PhD they wouldn't need this book. Just because someone is at the level of knowledge to get a PhD in a subject, being a subject matter expert as we say, does not mean they know how to write a dissertation. A dissertation is a unique piece of work with specific requirements - and we need to know exactly what they are and how to put it together; so this book serves that purpose. I ordered this book on the recommendation of my Dissertation Committee Chair, who used it when he wrote his dissertation.

No doubt when you first enter graduate school you are excited, but the excitement soon wears off when you find yourself overwhelmed by the amount of work your dissertation or thesis has in store for you. Your approach and methodology to your topic is laid out for you in a simple "start to finish" way in this book. The text is quite readable and isn't overburdened with polysyllabic words requiring a dictionary. The second edition is up to date and takes into consideration that we are no longer writing our dissertations and theses solely from dusty library stacks. For example information is given as to how to evaluate Internet information and effective ways to Google.
