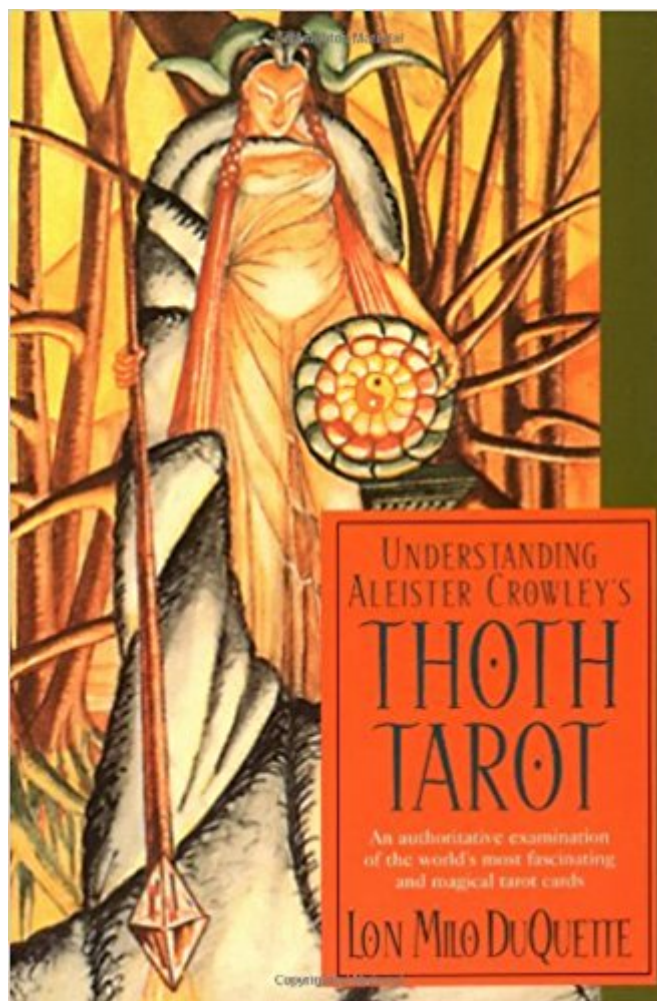

I've learned SO much from this book that I can't recommend it enough. If he simply went through all the cards, as so many other books do, well, his book would be like the others. But he goes over the underlying theory (if I might be forgiven for calling 5000 years of mysticism "theory") and sets a very nice basis for the things that are revealed in the Thoth Tarot. There are not all the many people who are actually qualified to explain all this complicated mystic information but he certainly is. And of the people who can explain it many of them would, no doubt, make it dry. But, good lord, he keeps it interesting. And all this explication is essential because the Thoth Tarot really is the culmination and the bringing together of many many mystic lines of inquiry over thousands of years. It would be truly overwhelming if Mr. Duquette didn't treat the subject with his incredible depth of knowledge and excellently accessible writing! As you might have guessed by this point, I highly recommend this

book!

Lon Milo Duquette is a treasure. This book has it all-- an overall history of Tarot, the background and contextualization of Crowley's 'Book of Thoth' and his relationship with the artist who painted the deck. The latter half of the book goes into the various associations each card has, from a qabbalistic standpoint as well as a more simplified quick reference chart. Honestly, if you've just bought a Thoth deck, this is the users manual. Pair this with his Chicken Qabalah for maximum results.

Lon Milo Duquette is a very entertaining and knowledgeable writer. This book is fun to read and very informative if you are starting on the work of Aleister Crowley and the Thoth Tarot. Duquette provides all the tools to start diving deep into several disciplines related to tarot, however I must admit this is good only for beginners. I would have liked to read a lot more on several subjects from Duquette's "pen", because, as I said, he's really a great narrator and teacher. The second half of the book seems to rush a bit compared to the first. Either way, here you'll find all you need to start your studies: card symbology, meanings, brief biographies of Crowley and Freida Harris and more. I bought the Kindle ebook, and here's the down side to this review: the adaptation isn't that good. There are several typos, but, most importantly, the very precious charts Duquette designed to explain the relation between cards and astrology are so tiny and blurry as to render them useless on a Kindle. They should have been placed in a vertical format or towards the end of the book as large images. The way they are presented now is not respectful of the author's work. Thanks to Duquette's explanation we can re-construct these charts ourselves, but it's certainly a drag.
