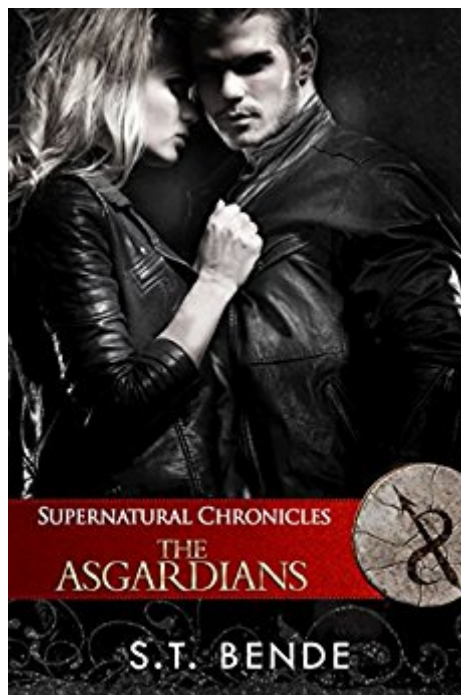


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Supernatural Chronicles: The Asgardians (Dynamis In New Orleans Book 9)

Reading The Asgardians felt like coming home; after finishing the Elsker Saga quite some time ago, and then being introduced to the sweet, funny new characters in Perfekt Order, being reunited with

Inga and Gunnar was like wrapping myself in my favorite blanket and settling in by the fire. I adore Inga and Gunnar, particularly Inga, who is tough-as-nails and profoundly loyal to her husband. In *The Asgardians*, we get some backstory on Inga, with a few scenes detailing her parentage and her time as just another friend to Gunnar and Ull. From even a young age she was fierce and determined. When the story switches to a different time, we watch as she maintains her loyalty and strength to protect her husband--and Midgard. S.T. Bende's writing has grown by leaps and bounds since she completed the *Elsker* saga, and she continues to add depth to these long-established favorites. Inga and Gunnar are playful and loving, but not over-the-top cute. They complement one another seamlessly. If you've already read *Perfekt Order*, Book One in Bende's *A Ere Saga*, you've already met Brynn and Henrik, the other stars of *The Asgardians*; if not, you'll be delighted to meet them here. This is the first crossover story of Bende's two worlds, and I truly hope it isn't the last! Fun, flirty, exciting, and filled with Bende's typical intelligence and attention to detail. Another great story by S.T. Bende *The Asgardians* is about Inga and her friends as they are given a task by Norns in order to save their immortality and to save the Midgard (Earth) from falling. From the very beginning this book sucked me in with an exciting ride of action, adventure, revenge, deep love, and loyalty. I loved reading about Inga and Gunner (who is definitely more funner) in this story. They have such an amazing relationship and chemistry. It's great how they have each other's backs and the love they share runs deep. Inga is a strong, brave woman and a great role model. Gunner is swoon worthy, supportive and protective of those he loves. One of the traits Gunner has that you don't always see in books is his ability to support Inga and help her accomplish whatever task she needs to do even if it puts her in danger. He doesn't hold her back even though he wants her to be protected. Brynn and Henrik are some of my favorite supporting characters. I am such a huge fan of those two. Brynn and Henrik added a lot to this story as they work together with Inga and Gunner. *The Asgardians* is a thrilling and quick read and definitely a story you don't want to miss.

This story is about how Gunnar and Inga overcame fear, revenge on Inga's mother's killer and how to kick some serious butt. I would recommend reading this book to everyone. S.T. Bende is a type of author that when you read her books she draws you in where you are living and fighting right along side the characters.

This quick and very fun read by ST Bende is a light-hearted *Asgardians* although suspenseful *Asgardians* play between her Elsker Saga and Aere Saga Norse god characters as they attempt to fulfill a quest given to them by the mysterious Norns to protect Asgard from a rising darkness. The story is told from the point of view of fierce, flirtacious Inga, a (sort of-) warrior goddess who is married to the hot, cheeky god Gunnar (#GunnarsFunner). Their quick wit, playful banter, and heart-racing romance are fun and pulls you into the story quickly. With their interaction with Gunnar's equally-hot-but-slightly-more-nerdy brother Henrik and his partner (as bodyguards to the war god), the bubbly, adorably-over-optimistic Brynn (or #Brynnrik together, ha!), the humor is endless and smoothly counteracts the seriousness of their dilemma and the grave danger they face in their battles. I loved that Miss ST even threw in a few little 4th-wall-cracking comments that stemmed from her Facebook group. :) I laughed aloud the whole time, startling those around me, and enjoyed it so much I read it in about two hours.
