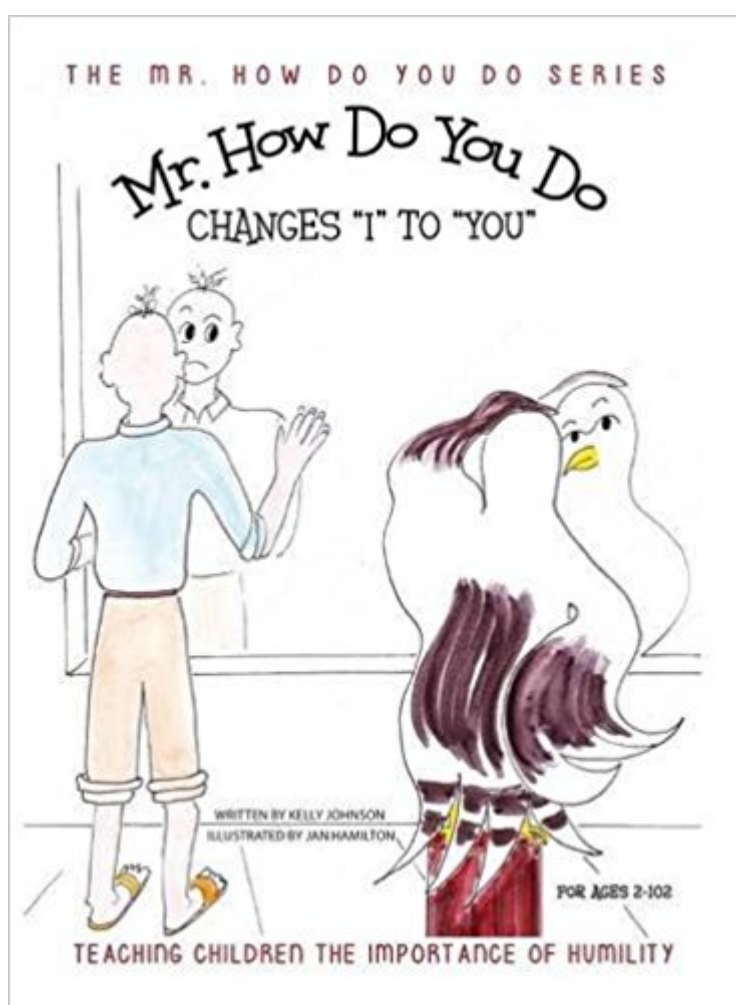

My 5 year old and 2 year old grandsons love the "Mr. How Do You Do" series by Kelly Johnson. They were so engaged with this particular story that they were quoting Sam Seagull before we were half-way through the story the very first time. These books are a wonderful way to begin a

conversation with children about some very important truths and character traits!

In the days of the "I" generation what a wonderful book to have. Illustrated beautifully and the message on PRIDE rings loud and clear. Reading it to my grandkids gives me a chance to show them the danger of pride in one's life. The tendency often leads to tragic consequences.

Our culture values the words "I" and "me" so a book like this proves countercultural. While, by and large, our culture seems to no longer value humility the Biblical principle remains true. Pride comes before the fall. This truth is conveyed in simple terms that anyone can understand. The illustrations are outstanding as well! This book has the best of both worlds. On one hand it is light and simplistic. It has wonderful illustrations that grab and hold the attention of young children so they stay engaged. Likewise, the writing style does an excellent job of keeping it simple and yet adequately conveying the principles being taught in the book. I shared copies with my church for their children's program, have copies for myself which my wife and I have read to our grandson on more than one occasion and I plan on buying more copies for other ministries. With that said, if you are wondering how you can help spread the Gospel in your community, you should buy a stack of these too!
