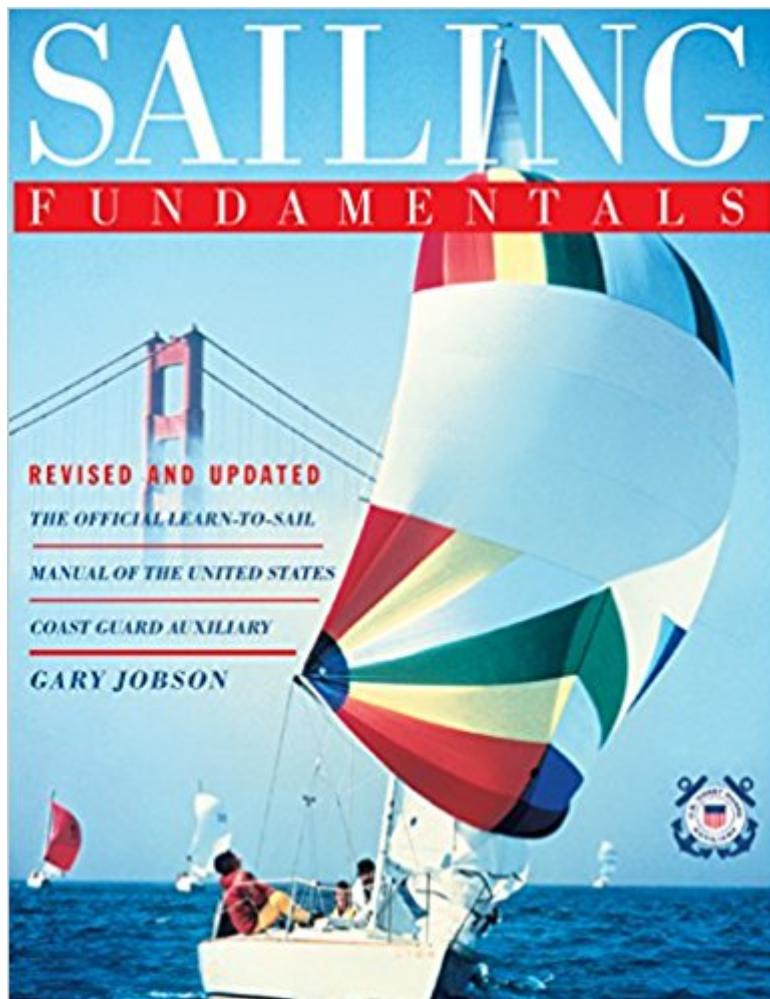

This book is a very descriptive text book for ASA basic sailing certification 101-104. Cruising Fundamentals will also be required for any ASA classes you may take in a Cruising boat. I would recommend that you also purchase Basic Keelboat (not the Kindle version) if you are taking either the US Sailing or the ASA courses. The ASA books are much more descriptive but have less diagrams where the US Sailing books are just the opposite. Between the two books you will learn much more than with just one or the other.

I got this book so I could have a teaching aid to help my girlfriend learn to sail. It starts off with all this info about jet skis and hull shapes instead of sailing fundamentals. I persisted with the book and the exercises were helpful, but was pretty disappointed. It's a pretty dry read and overly wordy.
