I first read this outstanding work over 40 years ago. At that time there were not many books of its type available. For its moderate size I thought it was the most comprehensive, thoroughly Biblical, practical, and experimental book on the subject of the Holy Spirit and His work that I had yet seen. Since then, many other books of its type have been published. In my own experience it was particularly useful in establishing me in a non-charismatic, non-pietistic direction.
