

Love the Ghost series. Fabulous fantasy. I'm giving it 5 stars because once I read the first one, I bought and read the entire rest of the series within a few weeks. Pros: Strong female lead, variety of foes, great character development, gripping storyline. Cons: As many people have said in other reviews of the series, the editing, if indeed it was edited, is horrendous. There are many, many, many grammatical errors throughout the book, sometimes causing the reader to backtrack and reread a sentence to understand its meaning. On that same track, a lot of the same phrases are used, especially during fight scenes when Caina uses her throwing knives, or when she fights magic wielders. Also, just to be nitpicky, I HATE ALL THE COVER ART. Do not judge these books by their covers, please. They are terrible. I found it funny that on a few of the covers, Caina is wearing leather bodysuits. Here is an excerpt from the second book: "In many tales, the Emperor's Ghosts were always women of perilous beauty, clad in skin-tight black leather. Caina thought that ridiculous. Black leather made too much noise, and reflected too much light. Instead, she wore loose black clothes, black gloves, and a black mask that concealed her face." Yet, on two of the covers, she is wearing tight, leather clothing. The others depict her wearing what looks like a kimono.... I am a very visual person, and I just feel as though the cover is one of the most important things to consider if you want people to read your books. In conclusion, despite the terrible grammatical/spelling errors and the horrid cover art, these are entertaining books to read. I couldn't put them down.

I guess this is more of a review of the series than just this book but this series is full of history and depth that keeps you wanting more and more. What makes it even better is that the world Caina inhabits is simply the stage for her exploits. The real story is Caina's never ending struggles against evil, especially evil magic. In most stories of this genre magic is used as a means to fight fire with

fire but Caina uses her wits to fight, in this book, the storm since she possesses no real magic or her own. I won't go into any detail about the book itself but I will tell you that you won't be disappointed with it or the series as a whole. I only gave a 4 star rating instead of five because of the grammatical/wording errors that in my opinion are easily forgiven but nonetheless do exist. How much gloss can you expect from an indi book anyhow? No offense to Jonathan Moeller who is an exceptional author. Also read his Demonsouled series!

I've read the entire Ghost series and this one is by the far the best. The action is fast paced and makes for quick reading. There are a few grammatical errors which are easy to get through. You will be better off to read the series in order to keep everything in perspective. At the very least you need to read Ghost in the Blood first. I am looking forward to the next book. I've also read the Demonsouled series as well. Another enjoyable series.

I went to bed for a quick nap but no this book just had to have all my attention. As always, Mr. Moeller crafts an exhilarating tale staring Caina and friends. I dread the day I finish reading the available Ghost books and must wait for the Mr. Moeller to finish the next. Normally I would have docked a star because I really didn't like how quickly the author moved from character to character, but this book, to me, was the best in the series so far. Full of action and kept you spellbound from start to finish.
