

I'm not exactly the right target reader for this novella. I have never loved teenage stories, not even when I was a teenager. But I must recognise that this is a text with a certain merit. It's well written, it has got a very good prose. The narrated story recalls vividly many more stories concerning young Americans: the less than innocent games, the skirmishes, the best friend fallen for the heroine but

irremediably confined to the friend zone, the heroine who isn't interested in love in real life but lives in the books she reads. They are well-known themes to which the author was able to give a personal touch. The fact it causes in me the same sense of annoyance that I usually feel for this kind of stories means that it works and that the fans of this genre will surely love it. Being myself a fan of mystery and suspense, I surely preferred the final part of this book, with the cliffhanger (one of my favourite narrative tools) which wants to push the reader towards the first book in the saga. The story about how he realized he loved Gemma was really sweet. I love that Gemma is so into books, and that she was reading *Clockwork Prince*! Love that series! And the Hunger Games mention was great! Peter and Gemma go to the beach with some friends, and it's all pretty much fun times, and Peter debating how to tell Gemma he loves her, and their other friends relationships. I enjoyed the story even without much to go on, and I'm looking forward to reading *Touched* next!

The story started out strong but started lacking towards the middle. I felt the story being drawn out for no apparent reason, teenagers playing games with fruit???? ok, that was really boring...then BAM it got really good then ended!! The first half was more about Peter who I'm not sure if he has a role in *Untouched* but I'm eager to find out. I like him. It

didn't really tell me much about Gemma, just that she loves books and feels alone. It's a pretty short Prequel and really don't think it should have been a stand-alone book. It would have been great in a book with several short stories but by itself, it was really lacking. I don't think I would recommend this one. That might change after I read untouched. If the pieces fit together I will review this again. but as of now I can only give this 3 stars.

Can't wait to get to the next book. I hope Peter finds happiness in the next book. It hurts when the person you love doesn't share the same feelings.

I'm not saying its bad, but I would prefer if we can get peter's perspective on after they meet even as well and when they meet him. Also, it's too short for 2 dollars and 99 cents so I think it's too expensive.
