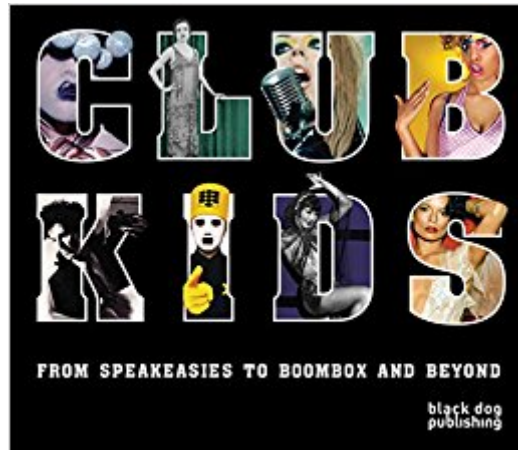

For anyone with even a passing interest in the history of club culture, this is a fascinating book that follows the development of this unique social aspect of human life. As someone who only knows clubs to be overrun with the stereotypical bro's and ho's, this gave me an appreciation for the times when clubs were an intersection of music, art, and spectacle inhabited along the fringes of society. You weren't turned away because you didn't look like you had enough money or weren't attractive enough -- you were turned away because you weren't committed enough to contributing to the atmosphere by dressing the part. Clubs were a place of freedom from the restrictions of social norms, the oppression of the majority, and the suppression of pure human enjoyment and pleasure. They just don't make them like they used to. Aside from some minor grammatical/editing errors and a bit of editorializing on the part of the author, this is a great historical introduction to club culture. Highly recommended!
