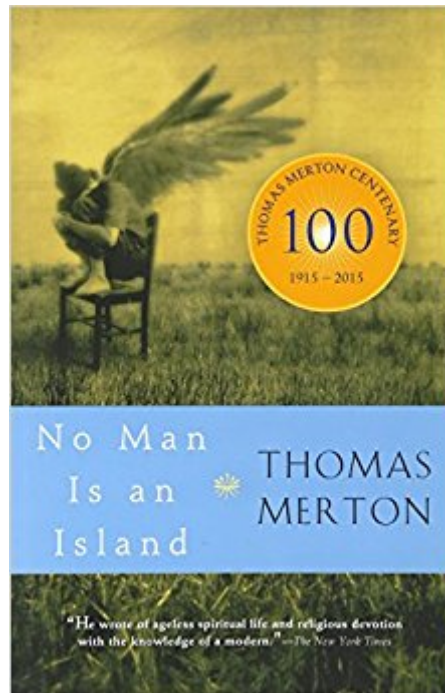




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No Man Is An Island

Thomas Merton (1915-1968) was born in France and came to live in the United States at the age of 24. He received several awards recognizing his contribution to religious study and contemplation, including the Pax Medal in 1963, and remained a devoted spiritualist and a tireless advocate for social justice until his death in 1968. *The Sign of Jonas* was originally published in 1953.

If there were ever a life guide that nearly everyone, regardless of belief or creed could relate to-it would be this one. In practical, searingly honest terms Merton gives us scriptural quotes and down

to earth interpretation to guide our waking days and to make our hours more productive. These are not simple language all the time-sometimes I had to re-read just to get the full impact. But that's the beauty of this book-you will find yourself reaching for it again and again. I have this on my Kindle but now I want the physical copy so I can mark it up and return to the passages that most inspire me. A "Zen and the Art of Motorcycle Maintenance" spiritual manual for the ages!
