But that's not what this was. Spencer Cohen has a fabulous life, after moving from Australia to L.A., he has amazing friends as well. His job is a little less than normal, he's hired to pretend to be the boyfriend of men or women, looking to win an ex back. Strange I know but it totally works. He's hired by the sister of Andrew, looking to win back his ex Eli. Spencer has never had a problem with his job before or "falling" for his customers. But the minute he meets Andrew, he knows there's something there. Has Spencer finally found the one?? The more time that Andrew and Spencer spend together, the more their attraction grows, but Spencer isn't sure if Andrew is really into him, or if he's playing it up for Eli's benefit. And let me tell you that ending will leave you thirsty for more!!!

OK, how have I never known that NR Walker is Australian until now? I don't recall noticing it before, but realized it when even when someone other than Spencer was talking (the only Australian in a story set in LA) non-American words and spellings were used. But it's no big deal, not enough to be a hindrance to getting through the book. I really liked both MCs, but was a little disappointed in the character development department. We don't get to find out by Spencer's family & past, or why Andrew has such low self-esteem. And there is really no resolution as to WHY Andrew's ex left or what was the deal with stringing him along. And we never get to see how Andrew handles the final confrontation, we only get to read about it when Andrew gives Spencer an abbreviated replay. That part was a bit of a let down considering that plot device comprised half the story. There's also no sex at all, and everything takes on a pretty much PG tone. I didn't mind that this book was first in a series, because I thought that each book was about a different "case". I had no idea that the entire series is Andrew & Spencer getting to know each other, so if you want to possibly find out about Spencer's childhood and/or past and the development of this relationship, then you have no choice but to read the rest of the series. This installment was only 10 chapters; in that case, the author could have combined it all into one 30 chapter book.

Spencer and Andrew are both very intriguing. I loved Spencer's fascination and attraction to Andrew. He loved Andrew's ivy league geek exterior and then little by little other layers were revealed and Spencer's connection and attraction steadily grew. I also found Andrew fascinating. Dreamworks animator, pianist, shy at times, but confident and a bit bossy at other times. I admit I want to see if the bossy and confident side of Andrew carries over to the bedroom. Hoping it does
