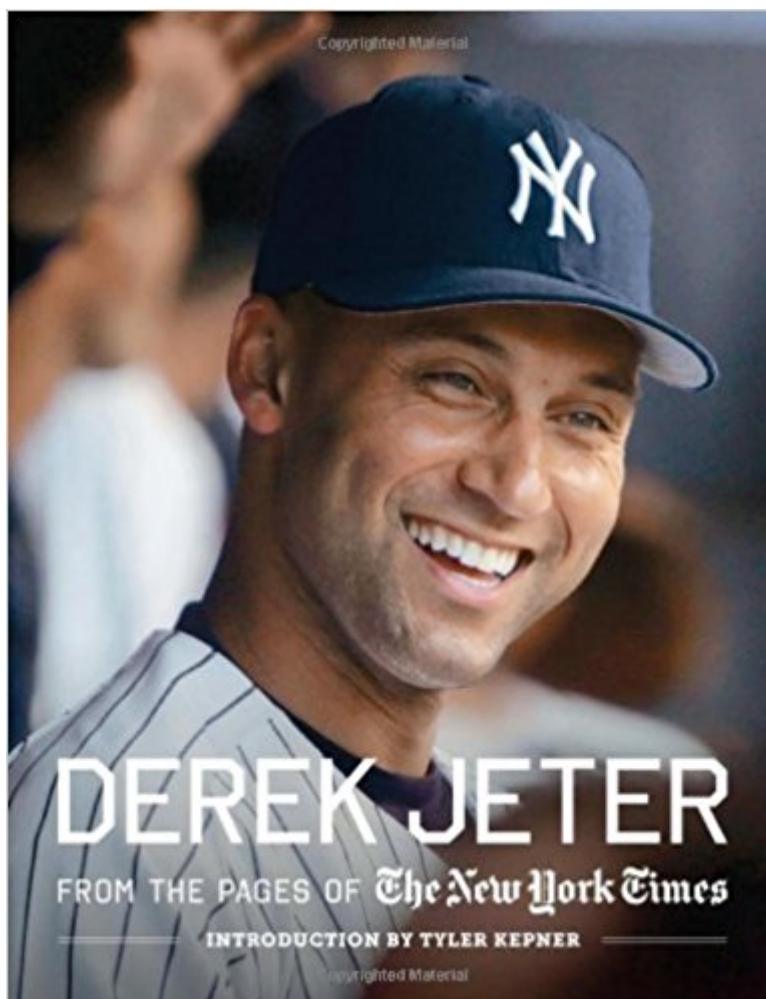


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Derek Jeter: From The Pages Of The New York Times
