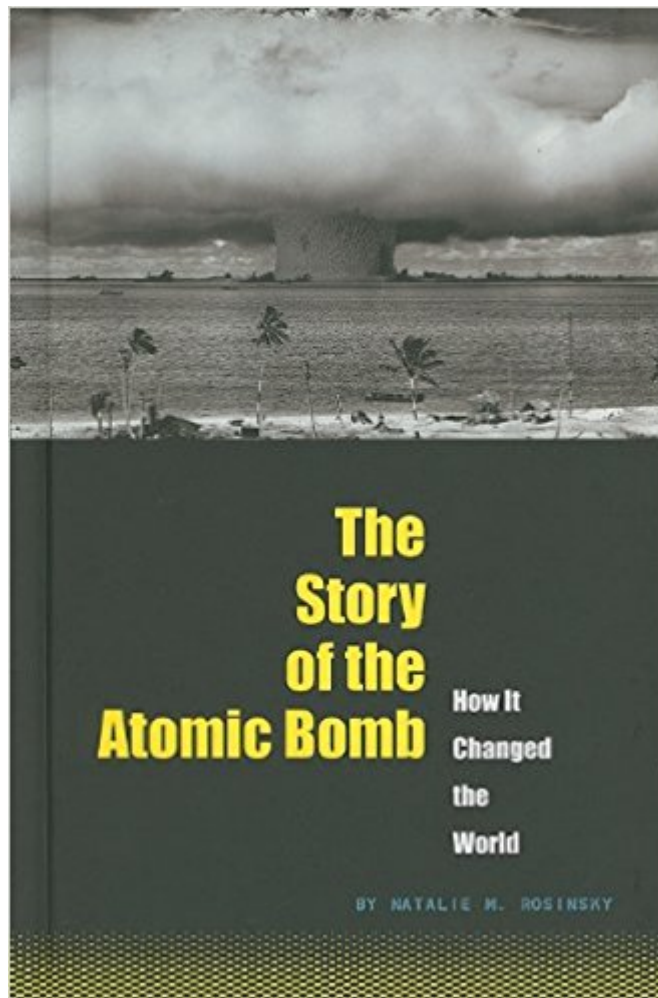




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Just before dawn on July 16, 1945, U.S. scientists conducted a test that would change the world forever.
