Excellent quality, large font, spacious margins around the entire page. Sounds strange, but at times while reading this volume, I almost forget I'm reading a Bible and I feel like I'm reading a letter sent personally to me by Paul. Is that due to the elimination of chapter and verse numbers as well as topical headings? I'll just say it feels more natural to read the Bible this way since that's how it was originally written. Or should I say it feels more supernatural?

I want to start off with the only con: I personally don't like the cover. This is only personal (and not

enough of one to knock off any stars)!The pros: (other than the fact that it's the Bible) the letters flow, and can be read in the original way the early church read them! It is so much easier to catch themes that repeat themselves in each letter. The paper is high quality, and the text is big enough that you don't strain while reading it. There is an introduction at the front that explains the importance of Paul's letters, especially in the wake of the reformation.
