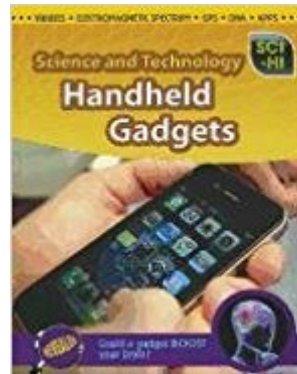




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Handheld Gadgets (Sci-Hi: Science And Technology)
