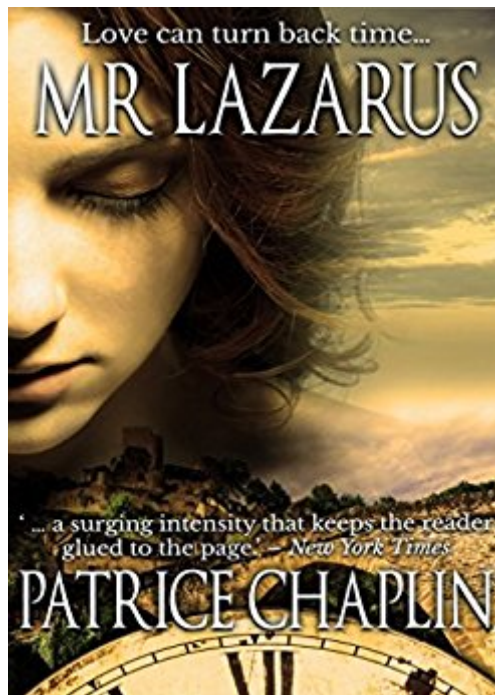

Vicky's journey through life chasing her childhood memories of seemingly magical portals - and chasing the possible love of her life - make for compelling reading. Mr Lazarus is inhabited by truly enticing characters, a fine sense of timing and just the right amount of dry wit and deep human insight. I highly recommend reading this book.

It's another Patrice Chaplin page turner. The title of this book was enough for me to dig in and find out the significance. It's a really good read. And true to Patrice's signature style, Mr. Lazarus is a multi-layered intrigue, with multi-layered meaning. Mr. Lazarus 'pulls you in' from page one all the way through.
