

This is a very thick good quality workbook with color work pages. I love this workbook because it begins with easier beginner basic map reading and skills and ascends in difficulty and skill in an apt way. There are a number of topics and skills included and each chapter and skill has many worksheets with brief paragraphs that explain each concept and skill. Each page is perforated and the pages are easy to take out and make copies. This book also includes a map and a sticker sheet for rewards. This book isn't full of lesson plans, but I homeschool and I use this book to guide me with my lessons for map skills and map reading. I am able to use the paragraphs

given on each page as a prompt for me to discuss and demonstrate the concept as well as use the worksheets for reinforcement. I am especially happy to see that each chapter and skill has many topics and worksheets to do. This makes it easy for my boys to understand a given concept. There are so many topics and skills covered that this book will have at least a couple of years of content to cover.

This seems like a great intro to geography, and I feel confident that my son will have a good understanding of the basics by the time we finish this book. We have only done the first few pages, and I know it gets more advanced further into it, but I can't imagine a 6th grader enjoying a lot of this. My son is eight and he is loving the fun and colorful way this book starts teaching, but I think most children over 10 would find it babyish. I would recommend it to anyone wanting to give their child an intro to geography in a fun and easy way.

I am using this to teach a group of learning disabled children about maps and geography. There was no curriculum available and this book just fit the bill. Now the children are talking about what direction they are going when they leave the room or exactly where their house is in relation to the school location. Very good purchase.

I got this for my boys to start learning more of the geography than the maps side of it but (we) they are loving it so far. We are not that far into it, but don't want to quit when we are working in them. I love that that start on a low level and in simple terms but "teach" what maps are and how they work. toward the end of the book they are learning latitude and longitude... which I also love because my oldest wants to fly helicopters for a living and what a great start to learning the basic as a kid!

This book is a gold mine for homeschool families! My two fourth grade children are now learning geography and this book starts off with the very basics and moves up as the children get more comfortable with following directions and developing map skills. This is an absolute amazing resource for any family who wants a complete map skills workbook.

Since I am frugal I dislike paying for books and not using the whole thing and this one is completely usable. The more simple/easy pages are geared well toward 2nd and 3rd grade and the more difficult/complicated pages are appropriate for a 6th grader. I don't have to skip very much to get to the challenging pages. This book is excellent for a student who needs to learn geography from the

beginning. Well worth the money I spent.

As a home schooling mom to a very, very ahead 7 year old (he's on a 3-4 grade level) I'm always scouring the internet for new ideas and ways to keep him engaged and entertained while learning. He loves this book. And I love it too! Every day is something different in here...learning about maps and how to read them (all different kinds), coloring, cutting and gluing stuff around rooms and spaces...its truly a great resource for introducing maps and geography OR supplementing what has been learned elsewhere. Get it. At this price and with such good material inside, you won't be disappointed (and neither will your child be). -ah

I returned this because my son is past learning what it has in it, which is unfortunate. I wish I would have found it earlier because it is a nice book for a 3rd or 4th grader who is just starting the 50 states. If we had found this at the beginning of 3rd it would have worked great with our homeschool curriculum. Side note, It is not a complete book of geography since it only barely touches anything outside of the US, but it is a good map work book. If you are doing the 50 states and basic mapping, this would be perfect.

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
